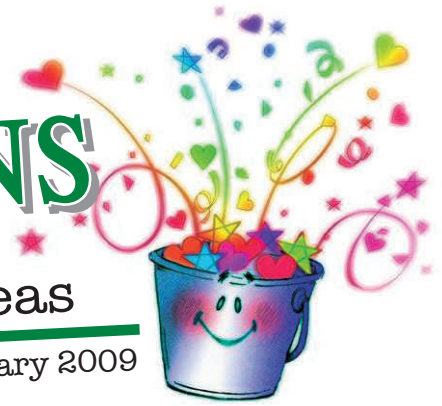

My Bucket Buddy

1. Write each child's name on a separate slip of paper and put them in a bucket, box or bag.
2. On a Monday morning, have the children to draw a name.
3. Explain that before the school day* is over, they must fill the bucket of the classmate whose name they've drawn.
4. Follow this with a discussion about good ways to fill someone's bucket.
